

Food Access Assistant Volunteer Position Description

Site: CFI office, 94 Columbus Rd Athens, OH; the Athens Farmers Market; Chesterhill Produce Auction; and other regional food access partner sites (directions provided).

Position Overview

As a CFI Food Access Assistant you'll work directly with the community, addressing Athens County's most immediate food security issue: access to fresh, healthy foods for all. This involves collecting fresh produce at the Athens Farmers Market and Chesterhill Produce Auction, distributing locally-sourced food through Donation Station distribution and/or through Veggie Van, and supporting other aspects of food access such as gleaning from local farms and supplemental distributions or food pickups.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Assist with food collection and community outreach for Donation Station and Veggie Van at any of the following times and locations:
 - Wednesdays at the Athens Farmers Market from 9AM-1PM (May-November)
 - Mondays and Thursdays at the Chesterhill Produce Auction from 3PM-7PM (May October)
 - Saturdays at the Athens Farmers Market, 9AM-12:30PM (year-round)
 - Assist with distribution of local food through Donation Station distribution and/or Veggie Van
 - Tuesday mornings 8:30am-11:00am
 - Wednesdays 3:30pm-5:30pm
 - Fridays 3:30pm-5:30pm
 - Other days/times, TBD
- Assist with other food access projects when available/interested, such as gleaning from local farms/gardens and assisting with supplement food pickups/deliveries
